The layout of the Luxia 375 yacht ensures **ample space** on board, both in the cockpit outside and in the cabin. The hull features generous volume while maintaining sleek waterlines. The beam and low center of gravity contribute to a **very stable attitude**, thanks in part to the gyroscopic stabilization system. The V-shape of the hull gradually increases from the stern to the bow, resulting in reduced exposure to the forces exerted by the sea currents and wind, enhancing course stability.

- A diesel fuel tank with a capacity of approximately 800 liters ensures remarkable range at both displacement speed and full throttle.
 Specifically, at maximum speed, the boat can travel 250 nautical miles at over 35 knots, which extends to more than 350 nautical miles at a cruising speed of 25 knots.

AFT PLATFORM

EXTERIORS

Luxia Yachts offers the possibility of integrating two types of platforms on the stern: **fixed or mobile**.

The fixed platform features a 1.3-meter structure with a centrally integrated ladder for easy water access. Its size and structural omega system allow up to three people to stand on it simultaneously.

The mobile platform, or S.A.F.E., incorporates an up & down stern movement system with retractable steps. When lowered, these steps facilitate a smooth and comfortable transition into the water and back onto the boat. When raised, the platform makes boarding from the dock easier, ensuring safety and convenience.

Overall, the stern platform expands the walkable surface of the yacht, **offering a unique sense of freedom and movement**.




DECK

EXTERIORS

Luxia Yacht uses a wood of undisputed beauty, highly resistant to water and immune to insect attacks: **Teak**. The unique qualities of this tropical wood ensure maximum comfort of use in **all conditions** and seasons of the year.

Moreover, the material comes from responsibly managed forests, respecting nature, workers, and all regulations regarding the origin of the wood, including the European Timber Regulation and FSC® certification.





STERN BENCHES

EXTERIORS

The benches located at the stern of the boat can be used in various situations:

- Closed with the high table: Ideal for having meals comfortably.
- **Opened**, allowing for storage of materials: A useful space to keep items organized.
- Completely open at the bow to allow access to the engine room.
- Closed with the lowered table and the cushion area opened for sunbathing use.

SUNSHADE

EXTERIORS

This is an exceptionally smart shading solution designed specifically for **luxury yachts**. The **awning disappears completely**, thanks to **articulated arms** that retract into their **closed position**, becoming virtually invisible and preserving the vessel's sleek **aesthetic profile**.

When deployed, the arms of the **Rolling Sun Awning** extend to the desired position via an **electric mechanism**, then retract back into their housing when shade is no longer needed. The storage compartment is designed to be **extremely compact**, **minimizing space usage**.

The awning fabric is made of **micro-perforated** shade cloth, available in a wide range of colors to create the **perfect combination** for any yacht design.



EXTERNAL KITCHEN

EXTERIORS

Behind the helm seats, it's possible to set up a kitchen unit, with a **fiberglass frame** and an **internal wooden structure** that houses an 85-liter fridge, an icemaker, drawers for utensils and recycling, a sink, a chopping board for preparation, and a ceramic glass cooktop. The cover is made of heat-resistant material, **suitable for outdoor use**.



AUDIO SYSTEM

Music is an integral part of the navigation experience. When you're offshore, you can alternate the calm of the sea with your favorite tracks by connecting your smartphone to the high-quality Garmin Fusion audio system via AirPlay® technology.

The speakers and amplifier installed on the Luxia 375 are specifically designed with materials tailored for the marine environment.

On board Luxia, the revolutionary **FUSION RA770** audio system is installed. Two years of research and development have led to the creation of the world's first stereo with integrated Wi-Fi, an anti-glare touchscreen, DSP amplification with profiling mode to optimize speaker sound based on the model and installation, an optical input for smart TVs, and PartyBus functionality, allowing you to play the same source in perfect sync throughout the boat by simply connecting your smartphone.

OVERVIEW

INTERIORS

The interior of the Luxia 375 consists of a kitchen, a dinette area with a table that can be transformed into a double bed, a guest cabin, a bathroom, and a shower with separate entrances.

The paneling finish is made with high-quality materials from the Italian company Cleaf, known for their superior elements and the creation of stimulating spaces. The interior flooring can be wood or have a concrete or stone effect. The ceilings are divided into painted sections and panels covered in fabric or natural leather.

The windows are arranged across the entire bow area, they are large and equipped with sunshades. In the kitchen, bathroom, shower, and guest cabin, there is the possibility of integrating an opening for proper air circulation.

The Luxia 375 is equipped with **air conditioning**. The air conditioning can be controlled both below deck and externally thanks to the integrated Garmin system.

The audio system is independent from the external one and allows you to listen to different tracks without interference.

DINETTE

INTERIORS

The Dinette area is a perfect example of how space can be optimized and turned into a luxurious environment within a compact area. This space is designed to maximize both efficiency and comfort. It features six seats, each with its own storage compartment. The windows around the hull surrounding the area make it bright and panoramic, with the option to limit daylight and ensure privacy with perimeter curtains. On either side of the seating, there are two speakers to fill the space with music, and a 28-inch television is installed on the bulkhead, connected to the internal network system. The dinette table is foldable, creating space for a comfortable double bed.



The interior kitchen benefits from a panoramic hull window, offering natural light and beautiful views. The cabinetry is seamlessly integrated with the **Silestone** countertop (composed of premium minerals and recycled materials) and the entrance panel. The sink is incorporated into the countertop, equipped with a designer faucet featuring a pull-out sprayer system. The kitchen is equipped with a sleek two-burner black induction cooktop, flush with the work surface. There is a 49-liter built-in refrigerator, a professional microwave oven from **Smeg** placed under the induction cooktop, and six drawers for ample storage space.



CUSHIONS INTERIORS The interiors of the Luxia 375 are upholstered with Batyline fabrics: an icon in the furniture market. Thanks to Smart Yarn technology - an exclusive patent of the company – the fabrics offer UV protection and resistance to fading. The fabrics have high resistance to UV rays, maintaining their color even when exposed to the sun, salt, and chlorine of harsh marine environments. Mold and mildew will not develop on the fabrics; simply brushing off dirt and debris is enough to keep them clean. They can be cleaned with bleach without losing their vibrant colors. The bedroom has an **independent access** with a wall-mounted door to the left of the descent below deck. The walls are covered with laminate from the Cleaf company, while the panels are unique in their kind. The collaboration between Luxia and the artist Ermenegildo Nilson led to the creation of an extraordinary work that dominates the front panel of the Luxia 375 bedroom.

MASTER CABIN

INTERIORS

In 2018, Ermenegildo opened his art studio, Arteria Palma, in the heart of the historic center of Ivrea, becoming a reference point for urban art in the region. His work goes beyond urban renewal, spanning from publishing to interior design, from sculpture to poster art.

This fusion between the mastery of Ermenegildo Nilson and the elegance of Luxia transforms the private space of the yacht. Ermenegildo's artwork is not just a decorative element, but a sensory journey that takes the occupants through a unique artistic experience. Every detail, every stroke tells a story of creativity and refinement, making the bedroom of the Luxia 375 an exclusive retreat enriched by contemporary art.

In this blend of Ermenegildo Nilson's visionary art and Luxia's timeless elegance, an experience aboard is created that goes beyond navigation, transforming into a **meeting between the sea and creativity**, between luxury and artistic expression.

Finally, the room features two opening windows to enhance air circulation, a bedside table, storage space, and two shelves with object fixtures, as well as a comfortable one-and-a-half bed.

BATHROOM AND SHOWER

FRIORS

The bathroom and shower have **two independent entrances**, allowing for greater privacy and are equipped with all possible comforts. The space is well-lit thanks to two opening windows and ceiling lights, with an additional light above the sink, placed laterally.

The sink and faucet are designed with a **Dekton countertop**. The doors and partition are made of glass, with curtains for the bathroom and a blackout for the shower. The cabinet offers ideal storage space to keep all personal hygiene essentials.









ANCHORING

The **Lewmar chromed winch** is a guarantee. Made of **stainless steel**, it features a new mechanism with larger shafts and gears. It is capable of preventing the accidental release of the 10 kg Delta anchor, which offers exceptional holding power on any seabed (including weeds). **It can quickly regain grip** when it tends to be dragged by the boat rotating around the anchorage point and increase its hold as the wind strengthens. The Delta is, in fact, the anchor with the best holding power relative to its weight and is lifetime guaranteed against breakage.
